Have you ever been surprised when something you were praying about was miraculously answered? I

must admit, I was surprised and overjoyed when God provided for us to purchase this land which we have now done. The church assembled and prayed on the land and gave thanks to God whose Hand is not shortened and is able to do abundantly above that which we ask of Him. Thank you brethren for being used of God to resource us to do His labours here in Thailand.

Despite Covid restrictions we were able to host several churches and their members for a three day meeting here at Nakhon Sawan. This was much blessed. The Thai Pastors that preached exhorted us to live wholly for Christ and remember His command to us to go forth into the fields with the Gospel and make disciples. There was a real move of God at these meetings and all returned to their respective fields feeling encouraged and strengthened to do more for the Lord.





We have seen several people saved and baptized recently, and we are always encouraged by this. The need is so great and the labourers seemingly few, but God is working and as the Gospel goes forth we are confident it never returns void.

Another one of our men, Phon, is about to do his compulsory army draw. This is required of all Thai men aged 20. They must assemble and in the presence of the military and many onlookers draw a marble. Red means you are conscripted and black means you are not. Normally about 80% of the marbles are red. Please pray God will lead with this, and I know Phon has been praying much and he says he is yielded to do whatever the Lord's will in this matter is.



Our midweek tract team, which goes out visiting homes and villages and preaching Christ, all these folk being people who themselves were reached by myself or one of our church folks previously, have been reporting good visits and considerable interest from people about how they can be saved and go to Heaven. We are

thankful we have answers for these questions about eternity and know God wants people to be able to KNOW they will go to Heaven. Jesus always was, and still is, the answer to men's spiritual needs, no matter what village or home or even country they are located in.

Suzanne has had her eyes checked by several doctors and though there is some hinderance to her sight, there has been no further deterioration of her eyes since they last checked three years ago. Praise God, please keep praying for her regarding her eyes, thank you.

I was sick for a few days recently and required monitoring at the hospital in Nakhon Sawan, but have returned to full health now, and though doctors have checked various things, they have told me all is well. They said my sickness was likely a viral anomaly and I have fully recovered from that. Thank you to those who prayed for me and helped us during that time. We receive your kindness as an expression of Christ's love through you and praise God for faithful caring friends who stand beside us come what may.

Please pray for protection for myself, Suzanne and Curtis as we move and minister around Thailand. The roads are extremely dangerous here and we need your prayers about that.

Pray God will continue to draw Thais to Himself and we will be led and directed by Him as we preach Christ out and about the towns and villages of Nakhon Sawan and throughout Thailand.

Pray for Tai's health, she has not fully recovered from her surgery, and we are concerned about her.

Thank you again, brethren, for your faithfulness despite the challenges Covid has brought to many of you. Like you, we believe the Lord's return is very near, and we want to be found on that day in the midst of faithful living and service for Him.
